Every year, DELABIE sells over 150,000 <u>spare</u> <u>parts</u>. This results in repaired products rather than discarded ones, preserving resources. DELABIE is now committed to supplying spare parts for 50 years across all its technical products.

If the <u>TEMPOMATIC 4 electronic tap</u> malfunctions, replacing just the solenoid valve, available as a spare part, costs 70% less than replacing the entire tap.

Spare parts are redundant if the products cannot be easily and quickly disassembled and reassembled. Therefore, these criteria are central to DELABIE's design philosophy. Alongside the information available on <u>www.delabie.com</u>, each product is accompanied by a simple and appropriate <u>installation guide</u>. Additionally, the company provides local access to responsive, technical experts to guide potential repairs.



#### Products made to last... since 1928

Since its inception, DELABIE has always prioritised offering high quality products that remain in use for many years. When time inevitably takes its toll, the company provides spare parts to facilitate repairs instead of replacements. For instance, <u>the TEMPOSTOP tap</u>, launched in 1993 and celebrating its 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year, continues to be widely used in many Public and Commercial Buildings. To ensure this longevity, a dedicated team of 40 people in DELABIE's research and development department adheres to an ambitious daily charter: creating products resistant to vandalism and intensive use thanks to robust materials and expert design.
