The grab bars are installed as close to the wall as possible making it easier to move around in the washrooms (showers, WCs, etc), providing greater freedom of movement and comfort.

The rounded profile of the Be-Line® grab bars, with a flat, ergonomic, anti-rotation front face, matches the shape of the hand perfectly, providing an optimum grip regardless of the location of the product or the type of user.

Maximum hygiene

The smooth, uniform surface of the aluminium grab bars is quick and easy to clean, meeting a fundamental need of hygiene.

Particular attention was paid to the design of the grab bars in the Be-Line® range to limit the number of joins and seams. This avoids the build-up of dirt and reduces the niches where bacteria can develop, particularly on straight sections which are most frequently in contact with hands.

Maximum security

As with all of DELABIE's Accessibility products, the Be-Line® range benefits from the Safety Pack: 10-year warranty, CE mark and tested to over 200kg.

In public and commercial places, the user weight is unknown. The products installed must therefore be able to support any user.

Available in two aluminium finishes - matte white or metallised anthracite powder coating - Be-Line® ensures a good visual contrast between the colour of the grab bars or shower seats and the wall.
